



SACS SUMMER/DAY CAMP 2023

Mission Statement: Children will experience hands-on, creative activities each day of camp along with age-appropriate academic challenges to jumpstart the upcoming school year. Campers will grow spiritually, mentally, and physically, while under the positive guidance of loving teacher/facilitator counselors.

Ages: 5 to 10 years old (current SACS students ages 3-12 may be accepted)

Grouping and Class Size: Children will be put into a maximum of two cohorts based on age. The expected adult-to-child ratio will be approximately 1:7. Maximum capacity: 28 campers.

Acceptance Policy: Children who are current SACS students in regular standing are eligible for acceptance into the Camp, along with siblings who meet the age requirement. In order to maintain a safe, happy environment throughout the summer, children who do not abide by the rules of the Camp will not be allowed to continue as participants in the Camp.

COVID-19 mitigation: We will follow SACS policies as applicable for camp.

Weekly Dates:

Monday - Friday, June 5-30, 2023 (payment due on May 19)

Monday – Friday, July 3-28, 2023 (payment due on June 30)

Up to one week of vacation will be discounted if the vacation dates are indicated at the time payment is due.

Hours: Eight hours/day included in camp fee. A charge of \$2.00/quarter hour or fraction thereof will be charged beyond eight hours/day. \$5.00/5 minutes or fraction thereof will be charged for each camper not picked up by 4:30 PM.

Fees and Due Dates:

Registration fee: \$50/student (due by April 28); \$75 after April 28

Camp cost: \$560/student per 4-week period; field trips, if planned, will be an additional cost for students age 6+. No discount given for missed days. Cost includes student insurance, art/craft supplies, and nutritious vegetarian snack. Up to one week of vacation will be discounted if the vacation dates are indicated at the time payment is due.

Late fee: \$25 late fee will be charged for payments made after the due date.

Dress Code: Campers should wear modest clothing that is comfortable for outdoor and indoor play. Tennis shoes or other closed-toe shoes must be worn due to sports activities. Unacceptable clothing includes: short-shorts, miniskirts, tank tops, bare midriff, and excessively tight or baggy garments. Logos or pictures should be appropriate for a Christian environment.

What to Bring:

Every day:

- ★ a healthy lunch
 - something from each food group: *fruit, vegetable, grain, protein* (if your protein is animal-based, please choose Kosher meats such as turkey, chicken, beef, etc.)
 - please avoid excessive sweets
- ★ water bottle
- ★ a smile ☺

Activity Days:

On Water-Play days:

- ★ change of clothes
- ★ towel
- ★ water shoes
- ★ sunscreen
- ★ one-piece swimsuit or shirt/shorts

On Bike/Scooter days:

- ★ bike/scooter (may keep at school)
- ★ helmet
- ★ sunscreen



To keep at SACS all summer:

- ★ *for children under 6:* a change of clothes for emergencies
